

INTERVIEW TRANSCRIPT: FRED COUPLES Sunday, June 30, 2013

Q. (in progress) That you would have been (inaudible) Kenny Perry, would you be surprised?

FRED COUPLES: Well, if you'd have told me (inaudible) I would have thought I'd shoot better than 68, but you know, there were a couple shots you always should have back. The putt on I guess it would be 15 looked so easy and I just hammered it and I kind of flinched at it coming down the hill. They played great, 6-under, and Duffy made a nice run but Kenny played very well and didn't make any mistakes and I sure did.

Q. Well, you know, it's always you've got to catch the breaks to win. You three-putted 7 where they're in the (inaudible) and make birdie. Then you hit the sprinkler head at 8 and that was really a bad break, that's where it kind of started.

FRED COUPLES: You know, I stood -- after three-putting the hole before and that shot, I said, you know, don't do anything stupid here, and I hit a 6-iron and I thought it was going to be in the middle of the green where I was aiming. It obviously flew too far, hit the sprinkler and went 30 yards over the green, but stuff like that's going to happen. I don't know if I would have gotten it up and down out of the back bunker or not, but it would have been a lot easier. But, you know, it was a little bit of a sour day the way I played after I teed off. I hit every fairway and drove it really well, so who knows.
