

INTERVIEW TRANSCRIPT: DUFFY WALDORF
Sunday, June 30, 2013

Q. Duff, you got out in 29, which was the low nine of the week. Just tell us about your start and then your finish.

DUFFY WALDORF: Well, I mean it was a great start. Obviously I felt like I wanted to get off to a good start today being behind, but way better than I could have imagined. I didn't even really work very hard. I was hitting it close the 14th holes and I just had it. The longest putt I made was about a four-footer on No. 1 and still 4-under par. I got fortunate on 7 and 8, got a birdie on 7 and got out of trouble on 8. I felt like I was sprinting in the mile and was leading the first couple laps and got to a spot with that 29 but wasn't able to continue to play well on the back. I misread the wind a few times, which led to a few bogeys with some short clubs in my hand, which was disappointing. All in all, it was a very good finish. Shooting 64 in the final round is pretty exciting.

Q. Kenny Perry, first major win out here, first major win ever. He really played some good golf today, didn't he?

DUFFY WALDORF: Yeah, I played with him yesterday, too. I mean, two 64s he had?

Q. Two 63s.

DUFFY WALDORF: Yeah, he played solid. The drives were in play, seemed like he was always around the hole. I think he had a putt on No. 11 which kind of turned the tide for him, it was going a little firm and went right in the center, and after that he seemed to be really solid, but he was solid all weekend. It's not surprising, he's obviously a great player. Winning these majors isn't easy and he did a great job this week.

Q. Especially going up against Freddy, too. (Inaudible)

DUFFY WALDORF: Yeah, I felt like my game was very good coming in here and I actually executed today for a change, I really putted well and got a lot out of my round. Freddy seemed to be a little bit snakebit out there. He hit a few shots that were unlucky, hit a sprinkler head, hit the pin. Also, I just felt like things didn't work out well for him even though I think he played as well as anybody, for sure.
