

INTERVIEW TRANSCRIPT: DUFFY WALDORF

PHIL STAMBAUGH: Just talk about the round. A nice way to end with a hole-out from the bunker.

DUFFY WALDORF: Yeah, it was a great way to finish. I had a bit of a jaggedy jigsaw round on the back side, pretty solid on the front. I was struggling a little bit hitting the ball in the fairway today. My putting was pretty good and my short game was good, just had three solid birdies on the front, no bogeys. On the back side I had three bogeys, which made it tough to score, but all in all it was a very -- I kind of just hung in there and scraped a pretty good round out of quite a bit of trouble off the tee.

PHIL STAMBAUGH: You just had a birthday two days ago and you debuted here at the Boeing Classic last year. Thoughts about coming back here to where you are started.

DUFFY WALDORF: Well, the first thing I can think of is one year ago I had my first round and went for 75. Played with Scott Simpson, who I played with today. I thought if I can just sneak under 75 that would be a great way to start. So I'm very excited to be back, to be back to my first tournament where you kind of have a little bit of an easier feeling when you've played the course before in competition, so I'm pretty excited to be back here playing this course that I feel like I know pretty well.
