

INTERVIEW TRANSCRIPT: BOBBY CLAMPETT Saturday, August 24, 2013

Q. You had a good day.

BOBBY CLAMPETT: Thanks. Yeah, I played well. Yesterday I got some good breaks, today it wasn't quite as good of breaks. It was a good day.

Q. You're in plays 2nd but only one guy in front of you. Do you feel like you're in a pretty good spot for tomorrow?

BOBBY CLAMPETT: Yeah, the whole key is to be in position. Like Tom Watson once said, he said in golf it's not about the kill, it's about the hunt, and I haven't been in the hunt lately so this is nice to get back in it.

Q. Does the course set up well for you, are you just playing better this week?

BOBBY CLAMPETT: That's a great question. Clearly yesterday it seemed like I had a lot of good numbers and it just flowed really well yesterday. Today the second nine was a little different. The last hole's a perfect example. I hit a really good second shot in there but I was caught between clubs and could have hit the 3-wood or 5-wood, but I was kind of in between a lot today, especially the back nine. But it's a hard golf course. It's not an easy golf course at all. You have to have a lot of patience. You can hit good shots. Like I thought I hit a good second shot on 16 today with a hard pitching wedge and it landed just past the hole and bounced over the green. I wasn't really expecting that when you're pitching into a three to four percent slope like that and see the ball with a pitching wedge, a hard spinning pitching wedge.

Q. Yeah, I was watching it on TV, it was surprising.

BOBBY CLAMPETT: Yeah, so those kinds of things. But it's a patience golf course and the key is really try to stay away from bogeys. I've only made one this week and that's been a big key.

Q. Are you coming back (unintelligible) adds confidence for tomorrow?

BOBBY CLAMPETT: Sure. For me it's three good tournament rounds in a row. I played well on Sunday last week, so shot three straight rounds in the 60s, that's a good sign, and I shot 66 in the Monday qualifier last week, so I'm showing some signs. The week before I shot 8-under for three rounds. There's some signs there. I'm just trying to be patient when you get your weeks, and when you don't, you can't force the matter, you've got to just execute and total them up at the end and see how

you do.

Q. Any score in mind tomorrow?

BOBBY CLAMPETT: No, no, I'm going to go out with the same attitude and be aggressive where I can be aggressive and put the ball in the middle of the greens when I need to and try to make a bunch of putts, try to get in the flow and make a bunch of birdies. Look what John did today. I played with him on Sunday last week, to shoot 8-under out here. I played with Mark O'Meara last year in the second round and he shot 8-under. It's just some phenomenal golf. This is a hard golf course.
