



2nd ROUND INTERVIEW TRANSCRIPT: STEWART CINK

Q. Just talk about the round today. Kind of kept it together and still right up at the leaderboard.

STEWART CINK: Yeah, it was really solid tee to green again today, but the South course just doesn't yield it. You can hit it great all day long and you're still looking at a lot of 30-footers out there. I had a lot of those and I was really proud of the way I hung in there today and kept on doing my thing. I didn't really putt well the second half, but I think that's natural. Got a little tight on the putting greens and left a few putts short, so not very surprising, but looking forward to getting after it.

Q. Thoughts on tomorrow being the last group going into the weekend?

STEWART CINK: Yeah, well, I'm looking forward to playing with Jordan. I've never seen him hit a ball, so that will be fun. It's always exciting to see the young guys play. I'm playing really well, I'm really excited about golf right now and the way I'm playing. I'm having some fun out there and seeing a lot of good things, so I'm looking forward to the next couple days, going to be a lot of fun out there.

Q. Did you do anything in the off-season where you kind of saw this trending towards some positive results?

STEWART CINK: Well, not really anything specific, just continued what I've been doing for the last year really with my coach. We've been working on really getting my setup a lot better and my grip a lot better. Basics, you know. It's really started to feel much more comfortable out there and I feel like I'm in command most of the time with my ball striking. When I can get the putter sort of unlocked, I have a good round like I did yesterday. So maybe one of those type of rounds will come back tomorrow.
