

2nd ROUND INTERVIEW TRANSCRIPT: CHARLEY HOFFMAN
Friday, January 24, 2014

Q. Can you speak to your round? A bogey coming in, but other than that how do you feel?

CHARLEY HOFFMAN: I'm pretty pissed off right now making bogey on the last hole, I won't lie. Got out of position and just kept out of position. Not real happy, wanted to get a few more on the North course. Starting the week I knew the North course is where I needed to get it and I didn't do it and I'm not real happy.

Q. You're still 5 back. I know you just got off the course, but that's not a bad position to be I'm guessing?

CHARLEY HOFFMAN: It's not where I want to be.

Q. Charley, you weren't the only one that struggled over there. What is it about the North course that's different? It seems tougher.

CHARLEY HOFFMAN: I just didn't make any putts today. I hit it pretty good, besides the last hole obviously, but I just didn't make any putts. The putts I had I didn't have the speed right, and the putts I had the speed right they lipped out, so it just wasn't a very good day.

Q. We asked Pat the same things, he's 6, you're 5, you're 5 back right now it looks like going into the weekend. That's not terrible, right?

CHARLEY HOFFMAN: Like I said, it's not where I want to be.

Q. Yeah, okay. Is there a different mindset you have to have between the North and South? Everybody says I'm just going to play the South and do what I can on the North?

CHARLEY HOFFMAN: You know you're going to have wedge on almost every hole out there, so you know you're going to make a lot of birdie opportunities. The South course, you just take them where you can. I would say the mindset is to make birdies on the North course and I didn't do that today and I'm not real happy about it.

Q. Now how do you get out of the mind -- how do you get out of the mindset of like thinking about what happened today?

CHARLEY HOFFMAN: I gave it everything I've got, I'm just not happy with the result I got. I'm going to try to hit fairways tomorrow, hit a bunch of greens and hopefully the putts fall. If the putts start going in, I'm going to have a pretty good round hopefully.
