

**2<sup>nd</sup> ROUND INTERVIEW TRANSCRIPT: BILLY HORSCHEL**  
**Friday, January 24, 2014**

**Q. 5-under today, we just had a chance to talk to Morgan Hoffmann about how much easier the North course is playing and you said the greens seem a little bit slower and it's easier when you're able to reach the green in 2 on par 5s.**

**BILLY HORSCHEL:** Yeah, obviously we all know coming in this week that the North course is always going to play easier. I think the greens were a little bit softer, a little bit slower than what I played in the pro-am. But yeah, I mean, you've got to score on the North course. You've got to survive on the South course early in the week and you've got to score on the North course, and I did a pretty good job today. Missed a couple putts that I wish I would have had, but 5-under on that course is pretty good.

**Q. Do you have a preference on playing the South course first, then the North course, is it a little bit of a reprieve, or would you rather almost play North course then South course three straight days in a row?**

**BILLY HORSCHEL:** I think I would rather play North course and then go to the South because for me today I had a tough time getting the ball to the hole, the greens were a little bit, two feet faster on the South compared to the North. The North's got a little bit more slope in them so they can't get them as quick. But you know what, last year I played North and South and this year I played South and North and played well the first two days past two years, so it doesn't really matter. I'm just happy that I'm playing well.
