Q. At 18, no doubt you were going to go for that green in two in the situation you were in?

JASON DAY: Yeah, just looking at it right now, as I was walking off 17 green just after that little bit of a disappointment with that putt, but I knew I had to birdie the last hole and I thought if I could hole that eagle putt, get it to 9 and put a lot of pressure on the guys coming in. Unfortunately just missed on the high side, but glad I got the second putt in and right now we're just holding.

Q. How different did this course play today than yesterday?

JASON DAY: You saw, I'm sure the scores are a little bit better today. The greens were a little softer. You know, overall with how the course played was good, it was fair where the pins were. They were still receptive but very difficult. Overall, very happy with myself, how I played today, how I handled myself again. I've got a shot at it. And I played with Graham, who he is a good buddy of mine and he's been playing great golf. It's good to see him play good as well.
