

FINAL ROUND INTERVIEW TRANSCRIPT: GRAHAM DeLAET
Sunday, January 26, 2014

Q. Take me through that putt at 18. That was money the whole way.

GRAHAM DeLAET: Yeah, I mean, it kind of looked like one of those ones if I started at the left edge it was going to break right, if I started right edge it was going to kind of come back in, so I just went dead at it and it held its line perfectly the whole way.

Q. Talk about this day. We're seeing a lot better scores out there than we did yesterday.

GRAHAM DeLAET: Yeah, I'm not sure why, it's a tough golf course. I guess guys just kind of came to play here today, but what a test. Hopefully I still have a chance at this thing, but if not I'm happy with how I played.

Q. Jason just talk about playing with you and having such a good time, you're good friends. That had to help today?

GRAHAM DeLAET: Yeah, for sure. It's nice when you can like legitimately cheer for a playing partner and that kind of thing. He made a great clutch putt on 18 there, too. I didn't have any doubts the way he putted at the Presidents Cup, so it was great to see.

Q. Finally, when did you start looking at the scoreboard today?

GRAHAM DeLAET: You know, when I got to like 13 and I had that eagle putt, I knew then I think I would have tied for the lead at that time, so I was aware of it kind of the last six, seven holes.

Q. We just talked to Jason Day and he was saying that you guys are pretty good friends playing in the same group. Great playing today. Talk me through those 4, 5 and 6, you had 3, 3 and 3?

GRAHAM DeLAET: Yeah, I hit a bunker shot a little bit thin on 5 but I kind of got away with it, ended up being three, four feet past the hole. Then a great birdie on 5, which is not an easy hole unless you're in the fairway. Made a really nice putt on 6, just kind of chased a hybrid up there on the green and kind of got lucky it was the right distance and was able to hole the putt.

Q. What made this course a little more gettable today as opposed to the previous three rounds?

GRAHAM DeLAET: I have no idea honestly. It's tough, it's playing just as tough as it

has been the last few days. Maybe guys just kind of came to play here today, I'm not really sure why. But it's a good test and I'm happy; no matter how this all shakes down, I'm happy with how I played.

Q. Yeah, it's always the cliché question, hurry up and wait. What are you going to do now? Are you going to go eat, are you going to go sleep? What do you do to kind of take your mind off of this?

GRAHAM DeLAET: Yeah, I'm a little hungry, my stomach's growling a bit, so I'll probably just grab a quick snack and maybe just bang a few balls and kind of try to stay loose.

Q. Fear the beard?

GRAHAM DeLAET: Fear the beard.
