

FINAL ROUND INTERVIEW TRANSCRIPT: MARC LEISHMAN
Sunday, January 26, 2014

Q. What were your thoughts coming up 18, the situation you were facing and then how you played it and how it played out?

MARC LEISHMAN: I was probably going to lay up no matter what unless I had a short, probably 4 iron or less in. Yeah, I hit a good wedge shot. It was in a divot actually, so hit a really good shot and had a chance. Obviously disappointed it didn't go in, but happy I hit a good shot and gave it a chance. I'm just probably a little bit disappointed I didn't hole a few more putts, just seemed to miss everything I looked at, but that's golf. Hopefully I'll hit it well next week and hole putts.

Q. Did you feel like at a certain point it wasn't going to be your day or did you feel comfortable?

MARC LEISHMAN: There was never really a point where I thought I'm done. Standing on 16 tee I thought if I birdied the last three, it's mine. Hit a good shot and a good putt on 16, hit good tee shot, good shot and good putt on 17, and then just hit a bad tee shot on 18, but like I said, I was probably going to lay up anyway, it's quite an easy wedge shot. Just 2nd is not bad.

Q. What do you take away from this tournament moving forward?

MARC LEISHMAN: I'm hitting the ball really well. Do a little bit of work on my putting and hopefully do better next week in Phoenix.
