

2nd ROUND INTERVIEW TRANSCRIPT: OLIN BROWNE
Friday, May 16, 2014



Q. Well, Olin, 1-under today but good position going into the weekend. Just talk about the round.

OLIN BROWNE: It's a hard golf course, it's hard to get the ball close. The wind was really all over the place today. I think we played the entire front nine into the wind, and we got to 10 and 11 it was into the wind, and then 12 and 13 were into the wind, too. So you've just got to be patient, take your opportunities when you get them and try not to make too many mistakes.

Q. Any highlights to the round, any good saves that kept the thing going or any long putts for birdies?

OLIN BROWNE: No. I think I played the par 5s pretty well today, I think I played them 3-under today. I made another birdie somewhere, I can't remember where, but I made a couple of stupid bogeys and that's the way I do things.

Q. Do you feel good about your position going into the weekend?

OLIN BROWNE: Well, yeah, you want to get as many as you can because this is not the kind of golf course where you make up ground. You've got to be patient, you have to hit quality shots and you're just not going to get that many opportunities, especially if this wind continues. It's one of those things where this is a real championship test and you can see it by the leaderboard that it's a lot of quality players on top.
