

**2nd ROUND INTERVIEW TRANSCRIPT: KENNY PERRY**  
**Friday, May 16, 2014**



**Q. How about your round today? Awfully good out there.**

**KENNY PERRY:** Yeah, you know, this northwest wind is cool, blustery, a lot of craziness as it was shifting around through all those trees out there. Very difficult to choose clubs. I drove it better today and made a few putts, so played very steady. It was a nice round. Shooting 4-under, obviously there's a lot of guys at 4 and Jay's at 6, so they could really go deep this afternoon if it warms up. It was pretty chilly this morning.

**Q. You have to feel good about your position going into the weekend, don't you?**

**KENNY PERRY:** Yeah, it's okay. I'll probably end up probably being 4-behind I'm guessing, so tomorrow's a big day. Saturday's the rocking chair day as I call it and I've got to make my move on that day. I need to shoot another one of these or a little bit better tomorrow to get back into it for Sunday.

**Q. Do you just want to run through any details, any good saves or any long putts, any highlights out there?**

**KENNY PERRY:** No, there wasn't really much out there. Let's see, I hit it close mostly. Made a bad bogey on 9, I hit it in the trees off the tee and had to lay it up short of the water and made bogey. But I played nice on the back nine, I shot 3-under on the back. That's what I told myself, I said we've got to figure out a way to get it to 3-under, so 4-under for the day. At least get yourself a shot at it, get in this thing. They could really go low. It's really blustery out there, very difficult conditions.
