

**ROUND 2 INTERVIEW TRANSCRIPT: JOE DURANT**  
**Friday, June 27, 2014**

**Q. Obviously a little different, a little drier?**

**JOE DURANT:** Yeah, I didn't play as well today. I had a lot of in-between yardages, which was very uncomfortable because you're trying to take spin off or hit it hard and not spin it too much. It was just trickier today. I thought the pins were in some pretty good shots. I didn't drive it as good, so it was just a tougher day for me.

**Q. Even though you did get off to a good start?**

**JOE DURANT:** Yeah, fortunately I did. The only thing that saved me today.

**Q. But at 8, lead's at 11, so you're right in with 36 to go.**

**JOE DURANT:** Didn't shoot myself in the foot totally, so I'll just go out and play good this weekend.

**Q. Do you think if it keeps drying out it's going to change considerably on the conditions?**

**JOE DURANT:** You know, if we had four or five more days of the sun maybe, but it's still pretty soft I think. The ball's still spinning pretty well back on the green. I don't know, it will change some. The balls are bouncing in the fairway a little more now. It's drying out some. It's certainly a challenge, no question, especially if you hit it in the rough. I didn't see the rough yesterday. I got it in today and was like, I don't want to be in there.
