

ROUND 3 INTERVIEW TRANSCRIPT: JOE DURANT
Saturday, June 28, 2014

Q. What did you finish, two?

JOE DURANT: Three, so I'm 11, I think. I got off to a great start today. I eagled two, birdied seven, and then I made a really good birdie on eight. Eight was playing tough today, I made a really good birdie. After that I kind of went into neutral. I hit it in the bunker on nine, made a bogey, and after that I made nine straight pars.

Q. Anything in that stretch that kind of got away from you a little bit?

JOE DURANT: I just didn't make any putts, I wasn't getting it real close to the hole. I got a little tentative on some of the putts because they were on some slopes and I didn't want to keep leaving myself some long ones. So just a bit tentative, that was all. I played solid. Just got to go out and shoot a good low one tomorrow.

Q. How are the course conditions? I know it's been sunny. Has it dried out much?

JOE DURANT: A little bit. The greens are still relatively soft, but the fairways are starting to bounce a little so driving's a little more challenging, but it's still really receptive. So scores will be good again tomorrow.

Q. A lot of low scores though today.

JOE DURANT: Yeah, yeah. If you go out and just let it loose and don't worry about too many things, you can shoot a low number here.
