

**FINAL ROUND INTERVIEW TRANSCRIPT: MARK McNULTY**  
**Sunday, June 29, 2014**

**Q. Mark, good finish, your first Top 10 in a while in this event. Just talk about your day.**

**MARK McNULTY:** It's been a while, you know. Well, let's talk about the day first. I've played solid all week and the only thing downside for me was yesterday's round when I didn't hole any putts. Otherwise it would have been a lot closer for me. Maybe too frightening for my heart, this getting back into the game again. But I made a major little technical change with my swing three weeks ago with David and my own thinking, too, and it's really paying dividends. I've suddenly started to play well, swing well. It's nice to get complimented again. Little positive things that can happen.

**Q. Anything, without getting too technical, what you did for a change?**

**MARK McNULTY:** I've always sort of played with what (inaudible.) It's an optical illusion, looked like a square clubface but the hands are behind the ball. I would forward press and I would open up the clubface a little bit and I would have to come over the top to square up. I just squared everything up and got my hands ahead, left arm and shaft on line with what happens to be a closed clubface but it's a square, and then swing from there. It sounds simple and it is simple. This game's simple when you're playing well, but it's very, very difficult when you're not.
