

ROUND 2 INTERVIEW TRANSCRIPT: JOHN COOK
Saturday, August 16, 2014



Q. Just your thoughts on the round to start.

JOHN COOK: It was good for a while and then I struggled on the back side with my tee balls. If I struggle hitting tee balls, I struggle. So I need to be a little sharper off the tee tomorrow and we'll try to run him down.

Q. At what point did you know about the 59?

JOHN COOK: We could tell. I think we were on No. 6 tee. I know that he had made a par, so he was 14-under for the day with one to play. We figured he could get it in from there somehow. I guess he three-putted 18, but it's a phenomenal round, outstanding.

Q. Any thoughts about tomorrow, what do you think it's going to take?

JOHN COOK: Yeah, yeah, I try to set a score, try to shoot at it. If you have to adjust you adjust, but going to have to be 16-, 17-under par, which that's minimum. If we get good weather, that's very doable, but there's a lot of guys right there. There's plenty of guys that have a lot of experience within shouting distance.
