ROUND 2 INTERVIEW TRANSCRIPT: KEVIN SUTHERLAND Saturday, August 16, 2014



BILLY RAY BROWN: Here with Kevin Sutherland. Kevin, you join the elite group of someone that shoots 59. Coming into this week or maybe in the practice session today, did you see this coming?

KEVIN SUTHERLAND: You know, yesterday I got off to a terrible start, I wasn't hitting the ball well, and I kind of started hitting the ball well like the back side, driving the ball really well, and I started making a couple putts late in the day yesterday and managed to shoot 71 after being 3- or 4-over, 3-over. Today early on I was making everything and I made some very long putts. I got lucky on 7, holed a bunker shot that was kind of screaming across the green. I guess you have to have a couple of those to shoot 59, but for the most part I hit the ball really, really well and I made a lot of putts.

BILLY RAY BROWN: You were 11-under after 11. At what point in time during that run did you think maybe a possibility of shooting that number?

KEVIN SUTHERLAND: When I was 9-under after eight I was like, that goes beyond being a good start. At that point I started thinking, what do you have to do to shoot 59, and I started thinking maybe earlier than you should be but it worked out all right.

BILLY RAY BROWN: Your thoughts right now, not only the emotions right now but seeing so many of the other Champions Tour players watching you finish, tell us your thoughts.

KEVIN SUTHERLAND: That was -- I wasn't expecting that. There were so many guys here afterwards, it blew me away. It's emotional really to see those guys, the support you get out here. This is only my third tournament, but it's a great place to play.
