

FINAL ROUND INTERVIEW TRANSCRIPT: MARK O'MEARA
Sunday, August 17, 2014



Q. A few quotes about the round. You played awful good, one short of Bernhard, he's very tough. Talk about your week.

MARK O'MEARA: I mean, obviously I'm happy the way I played, especially coming home today. It's just disappointing. I think this is my 14th time out here I've finished second on this tour and it's not from lack of playing well enough on Sunday, it's just very difficult when you're going up against a player like Bernhard Langer, who in my opinion is playing as good of golf as he's ever played in his career. I know I've spoke about it several times about the opportunity that Paul McGinley has to maybe select him for the Ryder Cup team. If it was me and I was the captain, I've already told Bernhard this, he would be on my team. So my congratulations go off to him and maybe next week I can get it done.

Q. You've taken a little bit of a break here and now you're recharged?

MARK O'MEARA: I am. I'm going to play next week in Seattle, I'm looking forward to it. You know, I've come close there a couple times, got into a playoff one year. Hopefully I'll play well this next week. Then Calgary is an event I'm looking very much forward to. Last year was the inaugural event, it was amazing. And then I have a week off, a couple weeks, and then I'll play the rest of the season.
