

**FINAL ROUND INTERVIEW TRANSCRIPT:

MATT KUCHAR: ... middle of the day and towards the end, so it got fun, it got exciting. We saw that the leaders kind of got off to a slow start and we had a bit of a misstep with a bogey there on 2 and a par on 3. But then got it going nicely and it got to be pretty exciting. It was fun.
