

ROUND 3 INTERVIEW: AARON BADDELEY
Saturday, July 18, 2015



Q Just talk about the round. Really got it going today.

AARON BADDELEY: Yeah, it was a good day, played good overall. Saw a couple of tee shots that weren't spot on, didn't drive it well on the par 5s, but hit a lot of good iron shots today. And it was nice starting out the day with two birdies straight out off the bat, gets the round going in the right direction really.

Q Are you saying there's a 9 or 10 out there today?

AARON BADDELEY: I mean, if you play well, there's a couple of pins that the ball feeds to that you can make some birdies on. But also may hit a couple close ones on pins that are harder to get at like 17 and 8 were two tough pins to get close to. I hit close both times. So I hit a couple really good shots which felt good, which really helped. You know, you can't always rely on making 30-footers, so you get in there like three or four feet, it's nice.

Q What was different from today and the last couple days where you had a couple bad holes?

AARON BADDELEY: Just the couple bad holes I hit like poor tee shots, but today they were just not quite as good. So that makes it easy when you're not in the hazard, if you're just in the rough you can still score and get away with it. So that was like today, drove it in the trees a couple times, but just off the fairway where I could punch it back into the fairway and wedge it in and try and make birdie that way.

Q Looking forward I guess to tomorrow, how do you feel about your position, do you feel like you can contend?

AARON BADDELEY: It just depends on what the guys do this afternoon. If you have got a couple guys out there, if they go out and shoot a 7-under as well then you're still behind, but we'll wait until tomorrow and see where I'm at. I'm happy with today's round, and if I can shoot another good day tomorrow and try and be back on Sunday.
