

ROUND 2 INTERVIEW: JOHN HUSTON

Q. You've had some success here a couple years ago winning it all. In pretty good position entering Sunday. Your thoughts on the round?

JOHN HUSTON: It was pretty scrappy. It was a good score, but I'm not hitting the ball that great. Made enough putts and got it around and kept myself pretty close.

Q. Given the first day was only 6-under for the lead, today it's 10, you're one off, puts you in pretty good position. Do you think you might have a chance at this?

JOHN HUSTON: Yeah, I just have to try to shoot a good score. That's all I can do. I'm not really playing great, but I'm getting it around, so if I could shoot another score, who knows.

Q. Is there any holes you're not really comfortable with?

JOHN HUSTON: No. I mean, there's plenty of birdie opportunities if you drive it good, which I haven't really done. The greens are good enough that if you drive it in the fairway, you're going to have a lot of good chances.

Q. And what about this course this weekend just seems to be kind of going your way? I know you said you're playing a little scrappy, but minus 9 after two days, that's still not bad.

JOHN HUSTON: I don't know. When I've hit a bad drive, I've kind of gotten away with it and been able to still make a decent score.

Q. What's it going to take to post a similar number tomorrow?

JOHN HUSTON: I'm probably going to have to drive it a little bit better. I mean, I had the one three-putt, but other than that, I putted really good.
