

ROUND 2 INTERVIEW: COREY PAVIN
Saturday, August 29, 2015



Q. Pretty low round today. Talk about your thoughts on the round and what was working for you out there today.

COREY PAVIN: Well, I played well today. I made seven birdies and one lone bogey. I played very nicely, I hit the ball very well. Had a lot of birdie opportunities and missed a few, but obviously I made a few, too, so it was a good day.

Q. How's it feel to move up the leaderboard quite a bit, and it looks like tomorrow to be in contention, in the mix tomorrow?

COREY PAVIN: Yeah, it's always good to move up the leaderboard. That's always a good thing. It was a good day. Tomorrow I've got to go out and probably shoot another score like that to have a chance. We'll just see. I'm in a position where I can make a run hopefully.

Q. Why did it seem considerably more gettable today than yesterday?

COREY PAVIN: I don't know. I didn't really look at the pins to see if they were easier or harder or anything today. You know, sometimes we just kind of get used to it a little bit, the conditions of the course, and adapt a little bit. Maybe it's just more adapting out there to the conditions.

Q. Your shot on 16, was that one of your better ones today, the one from the fringe?

COREY PAVIN: Yeah, it was a really nice pitch I hit there. Actually, it was hard to see from where I was. I could see it kind of rolling, but it was hard to see if it was going to go in or not but it was pretty darn close. Those are the kind of birdie putts I like to have.

Q. Did you overthink the last putt?

COREY PAVIN: No, no. I just lined up and I just kind of eased into it a little bit and didn't hit it the way I wanted to.
