

ROUND 2 INTERVIEW: BILLY ANDRADE
Friday, November 6, 2015



Q. Just talk about how things -- 67 today, how your round went.

BILLY ANDRADE: Yeah, I had some opportunities on the front nine, I didn't birdie the drive-able hole that was right in front of there and didn't get that up and down. Didn't hit a good drive on the hole before, made bogey. What's the -- I was right in front of the green on 8 and didn't get that up and down. But I birdied 7, I birdied 9, I birdied 11, I birdied 18. Had some chances coming in. I had really good chances on 16 and 17 and 18, all about 15-footers for birdie and an eagle and didn't get them in. But overall I can't complain, I played pretty solid today. I didn't get off to the start maybe that would have been nice to maybe get off to a little better start, but otherwise I can't complain.

Q. Do you think with the greens being so fast like this, do you think maybe it gives you an advantage maybe over some of the other guys?

BILLY ANDRADE: No, not necessarily. We're all used to this, especially the guys that have played out here more than I have. The greens can get very tricky and very -- depending on where you are, you've got to really play defensive. I was that way on 17. I had this really fast putt coming down and barely touched it and almost made it, but no advantage there I don't think.
