

ROUND 2 INTERVIEW: KENNY PERRY

Q. Good start today and then the double on 7 but you were able to bounce back and had a pretty great round.

KENNY PERRY: It was definitely some serious peaks and valleys. I was 3 under through 6 and I three-putted 7 for bogey and I hit it in the junk on 8 and made double. Then I birdied 9, which really saved the round to tell you the truth. I was reeling from that double. Then I was able to play nicely on the back nine to get it back to shoot 4 under again. A pair of 66s, so it's got me right in the middle of the mix. It's going to take good play this weekend and hopefully I can battle Bernhard and Michael and the boys and we're going to have a good weekend hopefully.

Q. So you had a pretty good track record here over the years, you finished third here last year, fifth the year before. You're turning in the right direction. What is it about this place that brings out the best in you?

KENNY PERRY: Well, it's a ball hitter's golf course. You've got to be very accurate off the tee, you've got to be very precise with your irons, and the greens this year to me are the best I've seen them. They're super fast and I love really fast greens. That's what's got me -- I like it when you can just tap it, you don't really have to stroke it. I've won three Memorials, all those tournaments were super fast greens. Augusta, had a chance to win. To me, I play better when the greens are really fast.
