

ROUND 2 INTERVIEW: RUSSELL KNOX

Q. Russell, great round today. How much confidence are you playing with right now after a huge win already this year? Do you just approach the game differently at all?

RUSSELL KNOX: Yeah, I mean obviously my confidence is high but I'm as relaxed as I'll ever be. Yesterday was like I was just playing with my buddies. I mean actually I had to try and pump myself up a little bit just because I felt like I was going through the motions. I'm just trying to enjoy every minute of this and right now I feel pretty good.

Q. Well, it's definitely working for you. Your scrambling today was excellent. Off the tee, not finding as many fairways as some of the other guys having success. You had a great round today. Were you just a little off or is that something you're going to go to the range and maybe take a look at?

RUSSELL KNOX: I'm not really sure how I shot 65 to be honest because I didn't feel like I played very good at all. I like those rounds though because too many times I feel like you play good enough to shoot 65 and you shoot 72. Yeah, I'm thrilled with my round. My caddie suggested we go hit a few balls and I threatened to fire him for suggesting that. I'm just kidding. Yeah, I might go hit a few.

Q. I have to watch what I ask you then, right, if you're taking shots at your caddie for that. Well, you look relaxed, you're having a great time and you're very much a part of this tournament. Weather's going to be an issue over the next few days, so what are you thinking in terms of game plan? Do you keep going the same way or does the way the weather might move in, do you have to remind yourself to be patient for the next 36 holes?

RUSSELL KNOX: Yeah, I'm not really in a position to think about it or really even care about the weather to be honest. I thought making the cut was going to be a big achievement for me this week and so I'm thrilled to be in better position than that. If I play great on the weekend, super, and if I don't, well, super, too.
