

ROUND 2 INTERVIEW: HAROLD VARNER III

HAROLD VARNER III: Got a hot putter. I've been hitting it pretty well the last two weeks in Mississippi and here, so just want to give myself opportunities and obviously I did and capitalized on it.

Q. Obviously it looks fun outside the ropes. What's it like for you when you get in that type of zone where you're chipping in, feeling like you can make everything?

HAROLD VARNER III: It's fun. I played with Derek and he was playing well, too, so that was pretty cool going back and forth. But the course is there for the taking. If you get some good looks and get the putter hot, you can shoot pretty low obviously. I think there were some other low rounds.

Q. We've seen some other Web.com guys already win.

HAROLD VARNER III: No kidding, it's crazy.

Q. You put yourself in a good spot. Does that play any factor as far as the fearlessness that you guys all have seeing some of your buddies already contend and win?

HAROLD VARNER III: Yeah, it's pretty cool. Obviously Smylie and Grillo, he played pretty well. I'm just going out there and playing my game. I think my game's capable enough and I'm just going to do that.
