ROUND 2 INTERVIEW: CAMILO VILLEGAS

Q. What needs to be better over the next two days and what do you like in your game right now?

CAMILO VILLEGAS: Well, I have to hit it a little better than I did today. It wasn't pretty out there, to be honest. I managed to put a score on the board. The golf course was playing easier than it did yesterday due to less wind. Obviously it rained pretty hard in the morning before we played. They moved a couple tees up, made the golf course a little shorter and obviously the greens are pretty receptive. Like I said, the golf course was playing a little bit easier and I hit it pretty bad today but managed to put a score up there.

Q. That must give you some confidence, though, not to hit it the way you want to but still put a good score together?

CAMILO VILLEGAS: Yeah, but I'm going to do a little work and try to get things straightforward because this golf course, you've got to put the ball in play. Like I said, there was a few that I didn't and I managed to make a couple good bogeys and a great par on one of the other holes so I kept myself in play so that's good. Those days where you can lose it a little bit and you still hang are important to the game.

Q. Before we let you go, the last time we spoke was at the World Golf Championship's Bridgestone Invitational. You looked at me, you were very passionate, you said 2015, this isn't me, this is not what I'm all about. A little fired up coming into 2016? You getting ready to go here?

CAMILO VILLEGAS: Yes, definitely. I mean, I look at those world rankings and I know what I'm capable. Obviously it's great to be on the PGA Tour and I've got no complaints. I work very hard every day but it does give me a little of that, I don't know, I don't know how to say it, but I kick myself in the butt, you know what, I need to get where I believe I'm capable of and that's why we work every day.
