

ROUND 3 INTERVIEW: RUSSELL KNOX
Saturday, November 14, 2015



Q. Bogey-free round of golf and then you got a bad lie after a bad bounce in the rough on 18 and it results in a three-putt bogey for you.

RUSSELL KNOX: Yeah, I'm really annoyed with that because I played beautifully all day. To come out here, a good tee shot on 18, a tough hole, and not be able to make par was disappointing.

Q. Let's accentuate the positive because I thought you putted the ball and struck the ball beautifully for 17 holes.

RUSSELL KNOX: Yeah, no, I'm pleased. 65, I would have probably taken that before I teed off so I can't complain.

Q. Let me get this straight, you're from Scotland, live in Jacksonville, went to school in Jacksonville, just won in China and now you're trying to win in Mexico. I think you're leading the tournament in miles traveled this week.

RUSSELL KNOX: Yeah, it's been a rollercoaster start to this wraparound season, but obviously a great one for me. I look forward to putting my feet up next week, but another 65 would make it even better.

Q. No fatigue for you with all the travel?

RUSSELL KNOX: No, I am, I'm tired obviously, but kind of running on fumes and my adrenaline of playing well is helping me keep going so you never know.

Q. Russell, you made bogey at 18 but you played a great golf round.

RUSSELL KNOX: Yeah, I was pleased with that. Obviously to finish with a bogey is tough to finish, but overall I played beautifully from tee to green and holed some nice putts.

Q. What will be your strategy for tomorrow?

RUSSELL KNOX: Just got to go for it. I have the added advantage over the whole field of winning last week and I can just kind of freewheel it and I shouldn't have much pressure on me. So it's going to take a super low one but I'll aim at the pin and try and hole the putts.

Q. You have a lot of confidence, you won last week?

RUSSELL KNOX: Yes, absolutely. I know I'm playing well. I have one more day before I can rest so hopefully I can have a good dinner and come out tomorrow feeling energized.

Q. And the last one, the winner's call for tomorrow?

RUSSELL KNOX: Minus 20.
