

ROUND 3 INTERVIEW: GRAEME McDOWELL
Saturday, November 14, 2015



Q. You were able to get it in red numbers. What's the takeaway from today?

GRAEME McDOWELL: The takeaway is that the game's in really good shape apart from two driver swings today. I was really happy with the general progress and that driver swing's been haunting me a little bit. I've been hitting that shot a little bit the last few weeks. Turkey a couple weeks ago, it was really what killed me from kind of competing. It's kind of a work in progress, it's getting there. I've got to eliminate that for tomorrow if I want to compete. I've got to get past that first hole which is kind of killing me a little bit. But no, listen, it's all good. I'm happy enough with the way I'm swinging.

Q. If any guy in the field wanted a breakfast ball off No. 1 it would be you. What's been happening with that first tee shot?

GRAEME McDOWELL: Yeah, I played it on Tuesday and I hit it out of bounds. I hit in the fairway on the Wednesday pro-am and then Thursday morning I pretty much hit two balls out of bounds. One of them managed to hit something and come in. Something about the tee shot, I just don't like it. I've got the high rights going on. You've got out of bounds all the way down the right, pretty tight fairway, wind out of the left. I'll let you make your mind up why I don't like it.
