Q. Harold, great finish there with that par, scraping it out of the coral there, got it in the fairway. How much momentum does that help going into tomorrow?

HAROLD VARNER III: I think a lot. I get 10 more minutes of sleep, I think, and I'm just going to keep playing golf. Not get ahead of myself, just focus on the shot.

Q. How much does going right from the Web.com, getting through, getting your card that way and starting the Tour right back up with the momentum that you had playing well. Has that helped instead of having to wait for a couple of months to get in?

HAROLD VARNER III: I think it helps. You play the playoff events, which some of the guys we play with every week you're playing with so you're comfortable with those guys. I like playing golf. I'm going to play golf regardless if I'm at home or in a tournament so I would rather play in a tournament, for sure.
