

FINAL ROUND INTERVIEW: JASON BOHN
Sunday, November 15, 2015



Q. How would you describe what the day was like for yourself with all the stops and starts?

JASON BOHN: I mean, it's difficult, there's no question. It's hard to get into a good rhythm but it is what it is. We're playing golf so it's not that bad. I was glad we got to play a few more holes tonight, I think that's really good for the golf maintenance staff so they don't have to prepare as many holes tomorrow and I'm sure some guys in the field finished. But you just never know what the conditions are going to be like when you wake up and go back out there. It will be nice to know hopefully that we'll be able to finish our round tomorrow morning.

Q. How would you assess your play today?

JASON BOHN: Spotty at times, yeah, yeah. I don't think I did so great when I went back out in the warmup, I just didn't make many putts. But it was a little dark, to be honest. It's pretty difficult even when there's just an overcast, you can't really see the break in the green as well and I didn't really hit too many good putts coming in.

JASON BOHN: Yeah, it's a difficult situation, tough to start and stop, start and stop. It's hard to get into a rhythm when you're out there playing, but we got as much golf as Mother Nature would allow us to today. Hopefully we'll be able to get up tomorrow morning and actually finish our round.

Q. Do you think the conditions will allow you to play aggressive tomorrow?

JASON BOHN: Oh, absolutely. You have to play aggressive, especially as I'm probably a few back of the lead right now, so I'm going to have to really try to fire at some flags and make some burdens.

Q. Does it worry you that the course will be a little bit wet?

JASON BOHN: The course is going to be soaked, and if we get any more rain this evening, there were a lot of puddles out there on No. 13, big puddles in the fairway, but they've done a fantastic job for us to be able to play any golf right now.

Q. Finally, how is the Mexican crowd treating you?

JASON BOHN: Wonderful, yeah, they're great. We had a lot of people out there following us and it was fantastic. It's a wonderful place. I look forward to coming back every year.
