

**PRE-TOURNAMENT INTERVIEW: MIGUEL SUAREZ**  
**March 23, 2016**



**Q. So I guess just talk about your excitement heading into this week and what it means to play in an event like this.**

**MIGUEL SUAREZ:** This is my eighth event. I only have played last year. For me, it's a road to the Senior Tour. I have two and a half more years. I've been training in the gym, CrossFit, and I've been trying to get in shape just to try to make it into the Senior Tour in two and a half years.

**Q. So you've been trying to play in these events. Have you played in any other events really trying to get ready for the PGA TOUR Champions?**

**MIGUEL SUAREZ:** Yeah, exactly. I'm 46, almost 47. And these kids nowadays, they're hitting the ball so far, these courses are so long. For us it's hard, you know? I will do my best. I'll practice and I train, but my road is to the Senior Tour. That's my goal right now.

**Q. What's your comfort level like on a course like this?**

**MIGUEL SUAREZ:** This course is hard because it's pounding the ball, it's not finesse. It's more for guys that hit it far. You know, I'm more of a keep it in play, put it close, hard courses but narrow courses. It helps me here that the wind blows and that helps because I'm used to that. I was born in a place that is really windy and that's maybe my best attribute here on this golf course.
