

ROUND 1 INTERVIEW: AARON BADDELEY
March 24, 2016



Q. Two birdies and an eagle to round out your round, finished at 6-under 66. Is it safe to say you play great in windy conditions?

AARON BADDELEY: Yeah, I played really nice today. I feel like I only really hit like two poor shots. It's not easy in this wind, just got to be patient out here and that's what I was just trying to do. To have a fast finish like that was pretty exciting.

Q. You were mentioning previously about a new practice routine. Can you kind of talk about that a little bit?

AARON BADDELEY: Yeah, I've been working with Scott Hamilton since July and he's really just simplified my game. I've always wanted to get my full swing like my putting. I've always been a good putter and I've always just worked on the same things, a couple of main keys, and I would just forget about them and just putt and my swing was never like that. I could never really figure it out. Scott really got down to two main things so I just work on those couple things and then after that I just go play golf. I go on the golf course by myself and hit shots with two or three balls or I'll have a game with some friends.

Q. Lastly, can you speak to the course conditions at all, is it going to be more difficult for these guys in the afternoon?

AARON BADDELEY: Yeah, it will be a little more difficult for sure, but it was pretty windy this morning. It was a touch lighter for the first few holes but it got up to its normal. Yeah, I think the afternoon's always going to be a little tougher because you've got to play in that full strength of the wind the whole time. It is what it is. The guys tomorrow get the morning and we'll be in the afternoon.
