

ROUND 2 INTERVIEW: FREDDIE JACOBSON

Q. So Freddie, 3-under 69 today for you. Just talk about the day overall. Must be pretty pleased going into the weekend?

FREDDIE JACOBSON: Yeah, I mean both days keeping it in play well, haven't been in any trouble off the tee and hitting my irons really well, so if anything I might have hoped for a few more birdies. I had a lot of looks at it. Kind of very solid, I'm very happy with where my game is.

Q. How comfortable have you felt in the conditions so far dealing with the wind?

FREDDIE JACOBSON: You know, I don't like what's happening now, I'm not a big fan of rain and wind, but I do like playing in wind, especially when I'm hitting it all right. I kind of enjoy that. You've got to hit some different shots and work the ball a little bit so that suits me pretty good. It's been pretty windy these two days, afternoon yesterday and morning today, it's been blowing pretty good, but I like it.

Q. So just overall thoughts on the course, what's really been the key for you on this course, how do you think your game fits so far?

FREDDIE JACOBSON: I mean tee to green I've just been hitting a lot of fairways and I've been hitting my irons really well. I've just been keep giving myself chances. That's kind of the key here. The greens are pretty receptive, so even when you're downwind you can stop the ball pretty good so you can kind of attack it pretty good. So I'm enjoying it out there.
