

ROUND 3 INTERVIEW: TONY FINAU
March 26, 2016



Q. Tony, 5-under 67 today, you're in pretty good position heading into tomorrow. Talk about your round overall today.

TONY FINAU: Yeah, it was good. I got off to a pretty good started. I birdied the par 5s, which is my strength so it was nice. But it's good to be in the mix going into tomorrow. You never know how the guys are going to finish out there but just to be in the mix is kind of what we play for and so I'm happy about that opportunity that I have tomorrow.

Q. You've had experience kind of being in the mix at some other PGA TOUR events, being in the PGA last year in the top 10. Talk about how you think that experience will translate into tomorrow?

TONY FINAU: Yeah, for sure. In my first year I felt like I put myself in the thick of it a few times so I guess we'll see what I learned tomorrow. But so far I like what I've done this week and hope to keep it as simple as I have the first three days tomorrow.

Q. Take me through that birdie on the last there. How big is that, a momentum boost for you heading into Sunday?

TONY FINAU: That's huge. One shot, as we know, is sometimes the difference between first and second place. It's just nice to finish that way no matter how you're playing, but especially to be in the mix and to make a big putt like that was huge. It's been a while since I made a bomb, so that was nice timing.
