

ROUND 3 INTERVIEW: NICK TAYLOR
March 26, 2016



Q. Nick, 5-under 67 today, conditions much like they've been all week with the wind. Has it been pretty much the same wind all week long, south?

NICK TAYLOR: Yeah, out of the east pretty much every day. It's quartered a little bit to the south I think yesterday, which changed things a little bit. But yeah, it's been difficult. I think today it blew a little harder than it did the first couple days so it was a little more difficult, but I putted really well today so that helped.

Q. Was that the key to the 67, putting?

NICK TAYLOR: Yeah. I made a couple long putts on par 3s, I made a few, two or three par putts from about eight to 12 feet that were really huge, kind of keep the round going, so that was key for me today.

Q. Talk to us about 18. You were debating on whether to take --

NICK TAYLOR: Yeah, I was right behind the grandstands and I wanted to see what my option was because I had to hit over them. I wanted to see my option. The lie would have been great, more of a side-hill lie, so I thought I was in jail really regardless. So I was just trying to get on the green, and luckily I did and made a good putt to save par.
