Q. First 68 on Quail Hollow?

DANIEL BERGER: Yeah, I'm just thinking about dinner. I want some chicken parm and I think I'm going to go Italian tonight.

Q. Can you talk about the round a little bit, what was kind of clicking today?

DANIEL BERGER: No, I think me and my caddie were on a great little mindset and I've been playing good the last four, five weeks. I just feel like I'm in a groove and I'm having fun out there and that's probably why I'm playing so good, because when you're not having fun, it's usually going the opposite way.

Q. Has that kind of been the last four, five weeks kind of enjoying things a little bit more, is that kind of the key to your success?

DANIEL BERGER: Yeah, in the beginning of the year, my caddie Grant Berry, we split apart for a little bit and I didn't play that great, and then I got him back and ever since then it's been just easy. I mean, the Masters was awesome and then after that it's just been a lot of fun. He takes a lot of pressure off me. He just gives me the club and I hit it. It seems to be working out.

Q. In regards to your round today, talk about how difficult the course is playing, what you kind of saw, kind of the mindset going into tomorrow?

DANIEL BERGER: Yeah, it was windy out there and it's cold. Pins were in tough positions so you've got to hit quality golf shots. And like you saw on 18, I hit a good one in there and it went over the green and you're kind of screwed there. So you've just got to be patient and try to hang in there for as long as you can. There's plenty of birdies out there if you are.
