

ROUND 2 INTERVIEW: TIDD HAMILTON

TODD HAMILTON: I hit a couple bad drives early and I think that led to a bad drive on 16, made bogey there. I wasn't too focused. We had a little bit of wait on 17 and kind of between clubs. I took one more club. I should have taken the club I wanted to hit and been more aggressive with it. That might have been one of the best pars I ever made on 17. I would chalk that back nine up to the law of averages. I haven't been making any putts really for a while. Meaningful putts, anyway. I think I might have got my share today for sure, at least on the back nine.

Q What about now tomorrow, three-way tie going in. For fans, couldn't be much better. What is it from a player perspective?

TODD HAMILTON: Hopefully, we get some more good weather like this. I don't know, I haven't looked at it but it's not supposed to rain. Wind-wise, I'm not sure. I think it would be great for the fans. As you say, three guys tied and I don't know how many are within three, four, maybe even five shots of the lead. You saw a guy today shoot 9 under, so it's definitely gettable and that was with a little bit of breeze, too. So if a guy gets hot with the putter, he can make up a number of shots in very few holes. So you've just got to focus on what you're doing and take advantage of good shots and make sure you don't hit too many bad shots. If you do, try to recover as best you can.
