Q. Well, despite all the great scores today, at one point, a couple holes, you're back in the lead. Take me – first off, how did you feel overall today and then take me through 17.

JOHN INMAN: I'm playing well. I just, you know, it was a lot of club that I had and I was trying to just kind of chip a low one and I just got underneath it. It was a bad swing. I made great swings all day and I made a bad swing there and hit it in the water. And then the second shot, I was just shocked. I thought I put it right up there next to the hole and it spun all the way back down in the water. So now I'm really in another world. It was nice to get it on the green the next one and make a 20-footer for triple. It's always good to save a shot. I know I'm playing well, so I've just got to keep doing what I'm doing.

Q. Two shots, certainly not insurmountable going into the third day. Do you feel pretty good?

JOHN INMAN: Yeah, absolutely, yeah. When I'm hitting it in the middle of the clubface, I'm hitting some really good shots and the putter feels really nice and I'm not making everything but I'm making close to everything. So if I can keep that feeling, maybe we can do something good tomorrow.
