

Q. How did the round go today?

BRANDT JOBE: You know, I didn't play anything today like I played the first two rounds. I didn't drive the ball in the fairway and didn't have many opportunities to make birdie today, honestly. Ball striking just kind of let me down today.

Q. What was the course like today compared to the first two days?

BRANDT JOBE: You know, I would just say very similar. I mean, I don't think there was anything different. If you played really good, you could shoot under par. I saw some earlier scores, maybe the wind wasn't up quite as much but very similar wind, 20, 25 depending upon when you do it. Firm, fast greens.

Q. What area of your game today are you most let down by?

BRANDT JOBE: My ball striking. I've been hitting it good here for the last few weeks and rolled in some great putts today, but I just didn't hit the ball in the fairway, never hit it close. Frustrating and a little disappointing at the same time.

Q. What was it like to play in the last grouping?

BRANDT JOBE: Oh, it's fun. I mean, it's always fun. We'll just try -- I don't think I'll be in the last group tomorrow but you never know. I've got to go play a good round of golf tomorrow.

Q. What do you say about the way Bernhard played today?

BRANDT JOBE: You know what, I told my caddie walking up there, he had control of his golf ball today, and when you can control your golf ball on a hard golf course, you give yourself opportunities. He still made some mistakes and made some bogeys but he controlled his golf ball the best in our group and that's why he played the best.

Q. What are you looking forward to tomorrow, just winging it and --

BRANDT JOBE: No, I'm going to do a little practice. I'm rolling the ball great and the short game's all right, but today for some reason I was hitting my irons a little left and the woods a little right. So I've just got to go do a little work and figure out what got off.

Q. I saw you on 17, was that you with the baseball swing?

BRANDT JOBE: That was me. That was the second time over there so must be attracted

to it. That's what I'm talking about, I'm aiming to hit a draw and I'm blocking it. That's kind of the problem.
