

FINAL ROUND INTERVIEW: WES SHORT, JR.
July 10, 2016



Q. So that was a pretty good round there. Probably won't come out on top but you have to feel good about how you swung it this weekend?

WES SHORT, JR.: Yeah, I played pretty good. I could have made a few more putts but I putted good and I birdied the last hole so that helps out a lot.

Q. It seemed like scores weren't as low today. Why was that?

WES SHORT, JR.: The pins were really tough today. They had them well hidden, so it was tough to get it close. Somebody could get it going, you could, but it was pretty hard today.

Q. It always seems like the front nine is usually a little bit easier than that back nine. Did you feel coming in today that you had to get the low round on that front nine before going to the back?

WES SHORT, JR.: Yeah, I was hoping to at least birdie all the par 5s on the front and maybe get another one, and then the bogey on No. 8 kind of hurts. Then I didn't birdie No. 12, either, so I didn't do what I needed to do on the par 5s.

Q. This week in general with the whole tournament, how are you feeling about En-Joie and Endicott, New York?

WES SHORT, JR.: This is a great place. The fans get behind it, as you can see on 18 over there. Played with John Daly today so we had a lot of fans on every hole. They come out and support the tournament.

Q. Riegger, he's in the mix and he has the shingles thing. Can you just talk about how tough it is to play with injuries like that?

WES SHORT, JR.: I heard about the shingles, I've heard it hurts like hell. I haven't had them but I've seen the commercial for them. If you have them, that's got to be bad. So if he's playing with that, that's pretty good for him.

Q. Have you ever played with any kind of injury before?

WES SHORT, JR.: Back, I had some back problems and it's pretty tough.

Q. So what does it mean for him that he's in the thick of things towards the end?

WES SHORT, JR.: He's doing great because I saw him the other day and he talked about he maybe may not even play. That was on the second day after he was playing good, so you know it's got to be hurting if he's thinking about not playing.
