



HUDSON SWAFFORD: Saw Jhonny Vegas shot 60 today, that's unbelievable, but I feel like I played pretty well today just to kind of maybe put a little heat on him on the weekend with some birdies. I don't want just to sit around and try to make a bunch of pars so yeah, I'm pretty happy with today's round.

Q. The guys this week feel like this course is gettable if you hit the ball in the fairway and give yourself chances?

HUDSON SWAFFORD: Yeah, you've got to hit the ball in the fairway. The par 3s here are really some of the toughest group of par 3s on the Tour so threes go a long way on those. You can kind of attack the rest of the golf course from there if you're hitting fairways. But yeah, you've got to be careful on par 3s, center of the green. If you can two-putt from 30, 40 feet is always good. (Inaudible.) Kind of done a good job on the 3s this week.

Q. Got enough family here today?

HUDSON SWAFFORD: Yeah, we've got -- my wife's family is from Columbus so she's got a number of friends and family here. My family's from Tallahassee so it's not too far.

Q. Does that help motivate you having so many people here seeing you?

HUDSON SWAFFORD: Yeah, it can work both ways. I've definitely played a home game where I haven't played very well and I've actually won on a golf course at the University of Georgia. It's fun, it's kind of a relaxing week. It's good to have them all out.

Q. You said you've been playing pretty well. Do you like the way you're headed into this summer?

HUDSON SWAFFORD: Yeah, absolutely. I've been playing a lot of good tournaments, just really solid, just trying to put four together. I've been doing really well, maybe just one nine holes kind of slipped up and maybe just hold me back from a really good week. But played some really solid golf, really looking forward to kind of what I'm working on going into the Playoffs.

Q. Another great round today, obviously got a overshadowed a little bit by the 60, but you've got to feel pretty good about where you're at heading into the weekend?

HUDSON SWAFFORD: Absolutely, yeah. Just kind of talking to my caddie yesterday, shooting 3 under, I feel like I slipped (inaudible) just didn't quite get out of my round what I

really wanted to. Talked to him, we'd have to shoot about 5 under to get back into this thing. Obviously did a little better, definitely got a chance going into the weekend, that's all I wanted, just to be in the mix.

Q. You've got to be pretty good about where you're at, too, with having the double on, what was it, 11?

HUDSON SWAFFORD: Yeah, caught a flyer in the hazard and misjudged the lie in the hazard, played hockey a little bit. But yeah, I played great today all in all.

Q. You're not from Alabama but kind of a home game this week. Family's up, wife's family's up, tell us about that.

HUDSON SWAFFORD: Yeah, it's good. It's 45 minutes from where my wife grew up so she's got a bunch of family and friends up. My parents have some friends up this way about three hours from here. I played a number of SJGT golf tournaments up here on this golf course. I hadn't played it in probably 12 years, 13 years but I was pretty familiar with the golf course, knew what to expect. It's in perfect condition. Hit fairways, give yourself chances of getting in those bowls and you'll have a lot of good birdie looks.

Q. How do you go about chasing a guy who just shot 60? Just figure he's got to cool off a little bit?

HUDSON SWAFFORD: Yeah, play my game and just try to make a bunch of birdies like I did today and you never know. He makes a few pars and you're right there.
