



**Q. Jhonny, when did you think you had it going, with the hole-in-one or was it even before then?**

**JHONATTAN VEGAS:** Oh, it was way before that. I made birdie on 12, eagle on 13 and birdie on 14. When you go through that stretch something good's happening, so just let it go. Obviously made the hole-in-one, it's a little bit of luck but that was just the cherry on top of the cake. But it was a fun day, fun round, fun group of guys to play with. To be honest, even if it's (inaudible) golf, I enjoy that, just watching myself just play that good.

**Q. What's it like when you get on a roll like that?**

**JHONATTAN VEGAS:** You know, one, it's a lot of pressure, and two, it's real demanding because you always want to keep it going, you don't want to feel like you want to protect the score. At the same time you just want to shoot as low as you can so you've just got to forget that you're shooting that low and keep it one shot at a time and make every hole an opportunity?

**Q. Just kind of ride the wave or what?**

**JHONATTAN VEGAS:** You have to, you have to because it's so easy to get in the way of 8 under or 9 under or I don't want to make a bogey. You just have to forget about that and play every hole as you would have been any other way.

**Q. So you're set up pretty good going into the weekend I would say?**

**JHONATTAN VEGAS:** Oh, in a great place, no question about it. There's still a lot of golf to be played, but in a great position, yeah.

**Q. When you left here last night, did you kind of feel like hey, my game's at a place where maybe I can run away with it here?**

**JHONATTAN VEGAS:** I felt good about my round yesterday. I shot 6 under. I knew that I missed a few shots coming in that could have been a better round. I've been playing well throughout the whole year, the key is just keep the confidence going and hopefully we can keep that up for two more days.

**Q. To be fair, was 59 ever a thought in your mind throughout the day?**

**JHONATTAN VEGAS:** Well, when I got to 8 under I actually let myself think a little bit about

59 but I had to pull myself because it was so far away from that and just keep plugging along making some good putts, good birdies. Definitely wanted to do it, but 60 is still good.

**Q. If you take us back to the hole-in-one, A, when was the last time or have you had one before, and I guess the range of emotions as it goes up and comes down for you?**

**JHONATTAN VEGAS:** Yeah, that was just the peak of the round for sure, just going there. I had a perfect number, 190 yards is my 7-iron. I hit a great 7-iron, I mean high, right at it, turning towards the pin and I knew it was going to be fairly close but never expected to go in and it was just a great feeling seeing that ball go in.

**Q. You finished nice on 9. Can you walk us through 9?**

**JHONATTAN VEGAS:** Yeah, obviously I'm 10 under coming to 9, I know that I'm striking the ball well and I just wanted to be aggressive. That was my whole mentality coming into 9. I had 170 yards and hit a full 9-iron as far as I could and was able to make a great putt for a phenomenal round.

**Q. Nice little fist pump at the end there, too?**

**JHONATTAN VEGAS:** Well, you have to celebrate a round like this. They don't come that often and every chance you do it, I just have to celebrate it.

**Q. Have you had a round like this before?**

**JHONATTAN VEGAS:** I've shot 60 before on a par 70 being fairly close to this, but on the PGA Tour 63 was my previous best score so that was special for sure.

**Q. Now, you've always had the length, but is this week and maybe a few others in the past the best you've hit driver in a while just consistently?**

**JHONATTAN VEGAS:** I've been driving it really well. I think I've been putting well this week and that has been the key. I made some great putts and that has been definitely the key.

**Q. How do you kind of go to tomorrow after a round like this?**

**JHONATTAN VEGAS:** You just have to completely forget about what you just did today and know where you are on the leaderboard and focus for two more days. There's still a lot of golf to be played, too many good guys here that could shoot a 62 so can't really fall asleep with a round like this and just have to focus on playing two more good rounds.
