Just never started with any kind of momentum and that was the whole thing, just never had a momentum pretty much from the beginning of the round all the way to today, just couldn't make anything happen. It's hard to play that way. It's part of the game. I mean, unfortunate, but it is what it is.

Q. For the rest of the summer you've said this is the time of year you usually heat up and play pretty well, and going into the Playoffs you've got some momentum that way though?

JHONATTAN VEGAS: Yeah, it's good to put the scores that I put, especially the first two days, especially with big tournaments coming ahead. Obviously I have to get way better and manage situations better to really make a good run at it, but I'm in good position.
