Q. Hideki, you're right up there playing against the best. Do you think there is something specific you need to do to try and win a major?

**HIDEKI MATSUYAMA:** I have a lot to work on in order to win a major, but number one is probably putting. All I can do now is just work on my stroke and hopefully that will see me through.

Q. Are you missing your good friend Anirban here?

**HIDEKI MATSUYAMA:** Yeah, he's a really, really good friend and we miss him.
