

FINAL ROUND INTERVIEW: RICKIE FOWLER

Q. Rickie, 2016 comes to an end for you. Looking back at all the things you did, the win at Abu Dhabi, the Ryder Cup, what stands out to you the most?

RICKIE FOWLER: Well, the win to start the year was nice. I never started a year that quickly. But the Ryder Cup win was very special. To get to go do that with the guys and finally be a part of that was pretty cool. All that. Part of three United States teams, the Olympics, the Ryder Cup team and World Cup. So a great team year for me. Wish I could have played a little bit better through the middle parts of the season, but it was a memorable year for sure.

Q. How does the start of 2017 look for you, do you know the first few tournaments that you're going to start playing?

RICKIE FOWLER: Yeah, first few. I know for sure starting back at Abu Dhabi, HSBC there, go back to defend my title. I'll be back for Farmers at Torrey Pines, be back with the Thunderbirds at the Waste Management there up in Scottsdale. Three of my favorites to start the year and we'll kind of assess.

Q. Rickie, just real quick, could you assess kind of the week as a whole here? Felt like you played pretty well? Overall tough conditions out here but feel pretty good about the week?

RICKIE FOWLER: Yeah, not bad. Played decent. Felt good coming off last week in Australia and I was looking to get a good finish here. Decent, but it would have been nice to get ourselves in contention. Looks like definitely top-5. We're going to see where it plays out.
