

ROUND 1 INTERVIEW: BRANDT SNEDEKER

Q. Another solid performance around this property. You seem to love it. A solid 4-under 68. How would you describe it?

BRANDT SNEDEKER: Yeah, you know, probably didn't hit it as cleanly as I wanted to. Made a lot of great putts. Those new greens over there are perfect so if you get the ball rolling online you can make a lot of putts and I did that. So hopefully hit the driver straighter a little bit tomorrow and be ready to go. I love the South and love the way those greens roll, too, so I'm looking forward to getting over there tomorrow.

Q. Just talk a little bit about that putting because it was an incredible performance. You saved so many shots out there and made some very important birdie putts when you needed to on those new bent greens. You seemed to adjust straightaway.

BRANDT SNEDEKER: Yeah, they're rolling perfect so if you got reading them good which I felt I got a good report on early in the week, speeds were fast over there so if you get them online, they'll go in. Adjusted to them early, made some six, eight-footers, which is kind of what you need to do around here, especially with the rough as thick as it is. You've got to make some of those tough par saves, and I did that all day and made a couple long birdie putts and kind of salvaged a round that could have been going the other way and shot a good one. So hopefully I can get it going really good tomorrow and make some putts.

Q. Well, five top-3 finishes in 10 starts around here, there's no doubt you love this place and you're off to a nice start again this year. All the best.
