

**ROUND 3 INTERVIEW: BRANDT SNEDEKER**  
**January 28, 2017**

**Q. You hung tough again, another 2-under par 70. How do you feel about today?**

**BRANDT SNEDEKER:** I played great, I really did. I think I only missed a couple fairways all day. Had good opportunities, rolled it fantastic. For whatever reason I had four or five lip-outs and they all could have gone in. I had three birdies and they were all inside three feet. So one of those days. You have a day like that where the balls just don't want to go in around here. If you get rolling the ball like I did today and keep hitting wedges, I'll be fine.

**Q. Justin Rose is one of best ball strikers in the game and you outplayed him tee-to-green like nobody's business. How confident are you going into the final round with your record on this property and the way you're situated?**

**BRANDT SNEDEKER:** You know, I'm excited about it. You start out every week trying to get to the last group on Sunday. That's your goal. Get there, have a good week and on Sunday a lot can happen. So goal one for the week is to accomplish the last group tomorrow to have a chance to win the golf tournament. Goal two is kind of keep building on what I did today. (Inaudible) and do that again tomorrow. The putts will start falling in, and they will. That's part of the round (inaudible.)

**Q. Today you had more lip than Mick Jagger with so many lip-outs, but that's the nature of the game. You made so many putts out of the first 36 holes and now you're in the final round. The way you played at this property since let's say 2007, you almost replaced Tiger Woods and Mr. Torrey Pines?**

**BRANDT SNEDEKER:** I don't think so. I think he still has more wins here than I have total wins. This place has been special, and for whatever reason it seems like guys that have an affinity for this golf course, it kind of takes care of them. Seems like you see the same guys up on the leaderboard every year. Once you figure out how to play this place and understand the nuances to it, it seems to kind of let you be successful every year. So hopefully I can kind of build on it tomorrow. I'm playing some young guys looks like in the last group so I'll have that a little bit of advantage being here on Sunday knowing what it takes to get it done here and realizing what this golf course can do to you. So I'll pull on that past experience and hopefully (inaudible.)
