Q. How do you feel about your round today?

JHONATTAN VEGAS: It was a pretty good round despite a couple of bad holes that cost me a very good round. Probably I felt a little tired at the end because of the altitude and the conditions but the good thing is that I played well. There's a lot of golf yet to be played so I'm happy.

Q. Regarding the altitude playing here in Mexico, it takes a toll physically, so you probably have to have a specific plan in how to approach playing in the altitude?

JHONATTAN VEGAS: You have to get used to it. Most of the time we're playing at sea level and coming here at this altitude, it's really tough. But the good thing is that I played well, I feel that I played really well. I gave myself many chances and there's a lot of golf to be played until Sunday, and the good thing is that I feel I'm playing well.

Q. Describe what this week has been like and your feelings towards the Mexican fans.

JHONATTAN VEGAS: It's been spectacular. It's been so good that I have felt that I have to keep control of my -- not to be so fired up because so the people are so warm that they take a lot from you. It's a nice energy, so I'm enjoying it a lot.

Q. Finally, what do you think is going to be the winning score on Sunday after playing the first 18 holes and looking at the course?

JHONATTAN VEGAS: I believe the course is going to play even tougher. Today I feel it was playing a bit soft, but I have the feeling that it's going to get firmer for the weekend. I will say probably 13, 15 under could be a good number. Hopefully we can get there and see what happens this weekend.
