J.B. HOLMES: It felt good. It was a solid round for me. Conditions were getting tough. The greens were firm and some would really bounce and some would check on you, so it was difficult kind of knowing what you need to hit in there and hit it close. And the greens are getting really fast, so got to just kind of -- can't run in too many putts, you've got to just hope it trickles in. It wasn't easy, but they had some pins out there that you could make some birdies.

Q. Eagle on 1.

J.B. HOLMES: Yeah, the eagle on 1. Anytime you get any eagle it's great, but that putt was, it probably broke six, seven feet. I hit a good pace but it was on such a steep spot that it still could have went six or seven feet by, so I'm glad it hit the hole.

Q. Do you feel you're in good position going into the weekend at 5-under par right now?

J.B. HOLMES: Yeah, I feel like I'm in a great spot. Hopefully continue to play well and give it a run this weekend.
